"Strategical and Integration Considerations in ERM"

Dr. Roy Rimmington will explain a "merged approach" of Strategy, Risk Management and Performance Management that incorporates changes in the environment into strategy implementation. It proposes the use of explicit indicators that link external factors to corresponding strategic objectives.

This approach prompts an organisation to review its strategy, thrusts, objectives and related risks. It is expected to dramatically reduce risks for an organisation and help create value. Merging Strategy, Risk and Performance management provides a structured approach for external / operational risks to strategic decisions.
